MASTER ELECT'S MESSAGE



Greetings, my Brethren - as the Worshipful Master-Elect of Forest City Lodge #388, I am deeply honored that you, my Brethren, have enough confidence in my abilities to elect me to this most significant office. I have been acknowledged and introduced as a Past Master by Affiliation for several years now, so this will be my opportunity to finally earn the title.

We have a very busy calendar planned, with most of the usual events, some new ones, and some old traditions being revived. The Lodge will be going through some transitions, with several long-serving officers and committee chairmen retiring, and new officers with new ideas coming in.

Included in this article, along with my official portrait as Master of the Lodge, is my favorite portrait of my late wife, Marsha Newman-Willey. It was taken just a few months after our wedding in 1987. Although we only had about 10 years together, before her untimely death at the age of 43, she was a major part of my life, and her thoughts and attitudes continue to influence me. They are part of what shaped me as a man, and prepared me for this new endeavor. You will likely be hearing more about her in future articles.



A few years ago, for the first time in our history, the Lodge adopted an official Lodge pin. It was designed by several Brethren, and it included some features which made it unique among all other such Lodge pins that I know of. The pin contains much of symbolic importance, but it does not display the standard Masonic symbol of the Square and Compasses. Instead, it is fashioned around the shape of the Liberty Bell which, along with the red-white-and-blue coloring, identifies it as symbolic of our Freedom as Men, as Americans, and as Masons.

Our Lodge pin also displays the phrase, 'Pride in Brotherhood'. As a Lodge, we certainly have much to be proud of. We have been for some time considered by many to be the "flagship" Lodge of the 22nd Masonic District, and we became, quite recently, the first Lodge in the Grand Lodge of Ohio to achieve the Mark Twain Award – one of the most prestigious awards in Freemasonry worldwide.

While our Lodge pin mentions "Pride" first, it is my personal goal during this term to emphasize the second idea, that of "Brotherhood".

The Spirit of Brotherhood is what brought us into Lodge in the first place – each of us had to ask the recommendation of a friend to become a Mason. While we may not have known many – or even any – of the other Brethren when we first came in, we shortly discovered that we had a host of new friends and Brothers, men with whom we might never have come into contact with otherwise.

The Spirit of Brotherhood has kept us in Lodge all these years. It is that Brotherhood which brings us out to meetings, to see old friends and to make new ones, and to stand on the sidelines as the newly made Mason is obligated, while we silently renew our own vows. Yes, we have a well-deserved reputation as a "gourmet" Lodge, but it is not the warmth of a hot meal alone which brings us here – it is the companionship, the warmth of the Brotherhood that we feel here.

And so, as we begin what promises to be a very busy Masonic Year, it is my hope for this Lodge that, with all of our other achievements, any visitor to this Lodge will be struck by the warmth of our Brotherhood for each other – as some of the old stories relate, "Look how these Masons treat each other!"

He has shown us that many losses are avoidable by the simple exercise of brotherly love. Too often we rely on our Secretary to maintain our membership. The experiences of the past year teach us what is possible when Masters, Wardens, and Brethren share the responsibility of encouraging restorations and preventing suspensions.”

The message quoted above came from Grand Secretary Andrew White during the Grand Lodge Communication held October 21, 1966.

How will the future of our beloved Fraternity hold out in this digital age of social media? Who will write the future? And how will it all turn out?

But the even bigger question is, are you and I doing enough?

The last line of this excellent book which was published in 1980 states, "the history of Freemasonry in Ohio will continue to be written day by day... So Mote It Be".


