## TABLE LODGE – 2010

As he has again and again in the past, W.B. Julian Cohen chaired another very successful Table Lodge in Forest City Lodge. The highlight of this year's event was speaker, Tim Daley, who addressed the Brethren on Freemasonry in the Civil War, with a special focus on the "Friend to Friend Monument" at Gettysburg.

This monument was erected by the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania in 1990, and it is based upon an incident that involved three (3) Masons, namely Confederate General Armistead, Union General Hancock, and Hancock's aid, Bingham.

In addition to his address to the Brethren, Bro. Daley brought along a steel engraving that was made in 1876. It measures 46" wide and 25" high, and depicts the 3rd day of the Battle of Gettysburg, and includes the incident referred to above.

## Interested in a Night at the Races?

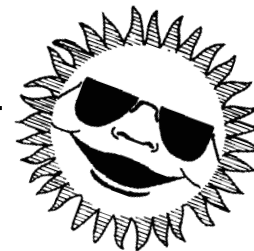

## **BROTHER MARK L. STOLARSKY** **SURVIVOR AND SUPERMAN**

In our last bulletin, we reported that Bro. Mark was to have his picture on the cover of “Ohio Sports Fitness”. Over the past few years he would email your editor with information about the “Light the Night Walk” in which he participated to help raise money for the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society. We simply assumed that this was either a worthwhile project that had attracted his attention, or that he had a loved one or a friend who had fallen victim to these terrible diseases.

**How wrong we were.** How could Mark Stolarsky, a virtual “health nut”, contract a disease such as lymphoma or leukemia? The revelation appeared in the April edition of “Ohio Sports Fitness”. Our brother ate healthy; exercised extensively; and saw his physician on a regular basis. He made all of the right choices, and was the real epitome of a person in superb condition.

Then one evening, things changed. The ‘night sweats’ began, and Bro. Mark began to feel sicker and sicker. He tried, without success, to work through the illness, but as he related “I was so tired, I couldn't work, I couldn't keep my head up, and this was just after one hour”. A subsequent visit to the doctor and a series of medical tests revealed that our Brother had contracted Hodgkin's Lymphoma, a cancer of the immune system.

What a horrendous blow to a man who during his years at law school would do 3000 push-ups and sit-ups in a single day. Once an avid runner, he was reduced to just a mile or two, and then not at all. BUT all his previous conditioning proved to be invaluable on his road to recovery, as he underwent thirty-two (32) weeks of chemotherapy, two surgeries, and one stem-cell transplant.

His doctors had difficulty believing someone could walk the hospital halls just seven days following chemotherapy. Today, Bro. Mark is back to his full usual workout, and is competing and racing. His two main races of the year are the Cleveland Rite-Aid Half-Marathon and the Fleet Street Sports Turkey Trot.

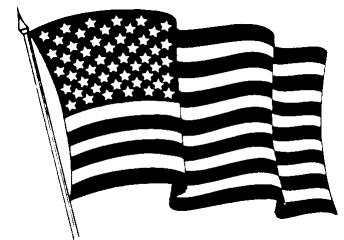

## SCOTS and FREEMASONRY

### Scottish Freemasonry

What is certain is that *Scottish* Freemasonry predates that of *English* Freemasonry. In 1483 the burgh of Aberdeen is recorded as having been involved in the resolution of a dispute between six “masons of the lodge” – not “stonemasons”, not “craftsmen”, but “masons of the lodge”. As Freemasonry began to spread, new lodges were established throughout Scotland, and candidates were initiated and given “The Mason Word”. The earliest surviving Lodge minutes from Edinburgh date from 1599.

In 1602, the Lodges of Scotland affirmed William St. Clair of Rosslyn as the Hereditary Grand Master Mason of Scotland from Time Immemorial. The following year when James the 6th of Scotland became James the 1st of Great Britain, he brought Freemasonry to England. It was not until almost 40-years later that the first man was recorded to have been made a Mason on English soil.

In Paris, in 1758, “The Grand Council of Emperors of the East and West” organized a “Rite of Perfection” which consisted of 25 degrees, the highest being “The Sublime Prince of the Royal Secret”. Less than a decade later, this “Grand Council” permitted the Rite to be taken to the West Indies and North America. Subsequently, “Scottish

Rite” bodies were formed in South Carolina which later became the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite – Southern Jurisdiction. With the formation of the Supreme Council in continental America, eight (8) more degrees, the so-called “Continental High Degrees”, were added to the original 25 degrees, to make the 33 degrees of the modern Scottish Rite.
