Continues to Grow

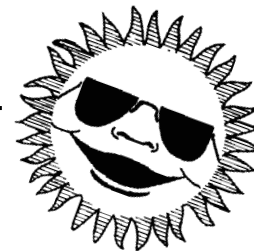

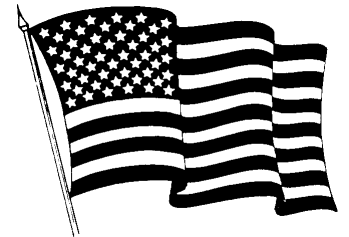

NEW FOR FOREST CITY LODGE – SEASON DINNER PASSES

As stated in the message from our Master-Elect, the Lodge is seeking ways to be more efficient with the funds available to us. One expense that repeats year after year is the cost of printing tickets for dinners – men’s and ladies. We always end up printing more than are actually sold, and the waste means \$\$\$ down the drain.

A new innovation this year will be ‘Dinner Passes’. There will be one (1) pass sold for the *Early Bird* dinners. We have scheduled a minimum of ten (10) of these dinners, and if necessary, there will be (12). The *Early Bird* passes, for Brethren only, will cost just thirty-five dollars (\$35.00). Depending on the actual number of dinners held, the savings to a brother will be between \$15.00 & \$25.00 as opposed to paying \$5.00 per dinner on a dinner-to-dinner basis.

A separate ‘Dinner Pass’ – one for men and one for women – will be sold for our more formal **event** dinners. These include (for both men and women): (1) Sports Night, (2) Valentine’s Day, (3) Jill Noble (latkes/brisket), (4) Veterans/Award Night, and (5) Memorial & Mason of the Year Night, **PLUS** for Masons only, (1) Annual Lodge Inspection, (2) Table Lodge, and (3) Past Masters’ Night. The men’s

‘Dinner Pass’ will cost \$55.00 (a savings of \$25.00), and the women’s ‘Dinner Pass’ will cost \$35.00 (a savings of \$15.00). There is also available a combined dinner pass consisting of the Men’s Dinner Pass PLUS the Early Bird Pass for \$80.00 (a savings of \$50.00).

PLEASE NOTE: Certain special event dinners will be sold separately, and they are not included in the ‘Dinner Pass’. These include the Master & Wardens Dinner Dance, the Annual Steak Roast, and a few others to be announced.

ALL ‘Passes’ must be paid by check payable to Forest City Lodge. Please indicate on your check the specific package(s) you wish to purchase. Please present your check to any line officer, or to our Social Chairman, W.B. Burt Task. Following receipt of your check, the ‘Pass(es)’ will be mailed to you. These passes are non-transferrable, and each will contain the name of the purchaser. They must be shown at the door where our ticket committee will have a printed list of ‘Pass’ holders. There will be no refund in the event the ‘Pass’ is not used for a given dinner.
